## IMPORTANT INFORMATION

### This Cruise Requires COVID-19 Vaccination.

Some North American cruises require vaccination for guests 12 and up, including U.S. cruises that stop in Canada or Bermuda, at any time All Royal Caribbean guests age 12 and older must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 with the final dose administered at least 14 days before sailing. We will ask that you disclose your vaccination status prior to boarding (via the Royal Caribbean app, on our website, or at the terminal). While Royal Caribbean does not require kids 11 or younger to be vaccinated, those who have been vaccinated may follow the test guidance for vaccinated guests. To be considered fully vaccinated, each guest's regimen must include at least two doses of vaccine unless the guest received the single dose Johnson & Johnson vaccine. A Certificate of Recovery is not acceptable in lieu of vaccination for guests of vaccinate eligible age.

### All Guests: Required Pre-Cruise Testing

Before arriving on boarding day, you'll need to take a COVID-19 test on your own, at your own expense. Vaccinated guests must show a negative test result for a supervised PCR or antigen test taken no more than 2 days before boarding day. Note: Kids age 11 and younger who have been vaccinated may follow the testing protocols for vaccinated guests. Unvaccinated kids age 2 to 11 must show a negative test result for a supervised PCR test (not antigen) taken no more than 3 days before boarding day, because that may affect the sample taken during the kids' test at the terminal. Guests under 2 years of age do not need to complete a pre-cruise test.

Onboard the Ship: Masks are optional for vaccinated guests and recommended for unvaccinated guests while onboard. Guests under 2 years old don't need to wear a mask. These protocols are subject to change. While Ashore: At public ports of call, guests should follow all local mask regulations. Guests under 2 do not have to wear a mask at any time.
